System Requirements

To use the Live CD, you should have at least 384 MB of RAM. Alternatively you can install Kubuntu directly from the CD start-up menu on machines with only 256 MB of RAM. You should also have at least 4 GB of disk space available for installation.

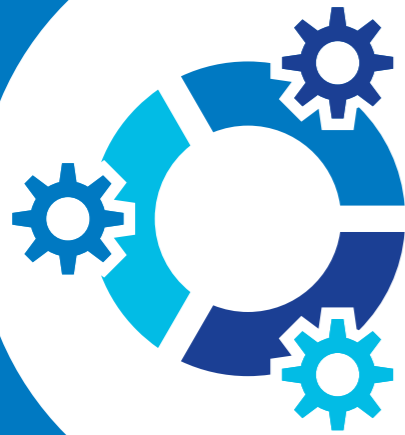

Use Kubuntu

To try Kubuntu, put this CD in the CD drive and turn on or restart your computer. This will leave your existing software untouched. If you like it, you'll have the option of installing it on your computer. By default, installing Kubuntu will erase all existing software and data from your computer. If this is not what you want, follow the instructions carefully during installation.

To try out Kubuntu from a Windows installation without repartitioning your hard disk, put the CD in the drive while Windows is running and select "Install inside Windows".
