The implementation might be based on Add/Remove Programs, Synaptic, or packagekit-gnome, whichever allows for quickest development.

## Downloads

Using the package manager that came with your distribution is the easiest way to install Epiphany. A few sample package installation commands that can be typed in a terminal window:

- Debian: `su && apt-get install epiphany-browser`
- Ubuntu: `sudo apt-get install epiphany-browser`
- Fedora: `yum install epiphany`
- Mandriva: `urpmi epiphany`
- SUSE: `yast -i epiphany`
- Gentoo: `emerge epiphany`
- Foresight: `sudo conary update epiphany`
- Arch Linux: `pacman -S epiphany`
- Frugalware: `pacman -S epiphany`
- OpenBSD: `pkg_add epiphany`

Most distributions also have a graphical software installation tool.

Epiphany binary downloads do not include dependencies, so please follow the above instruction corresponding to your distribution to install Epiphany, instead of downloading a binary.

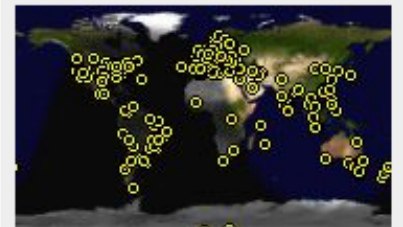

## Support for apturl syntax across Ubuntu applications

Support for apturl across Ubuntu applications, messengers in particular. A very handy feature (especially for support conversations), because instead of explaining someone the usage of sudo commands and/or synaptic to install a package, you only have to type an apturl link, like "apt:ubuntu-desktop".

### Whiteboard

I think implementing this is an important security measure. We need to establish an expectation amongst Ubuntu users, like Windows and Mac users already have, that you shouldn't accept terminal commands \*or\* sweets from strangers. Making apt: work everywhere is a big step towards that. -- mpt
