Installation

To install the module, I will assume you already followed the UD Theme installation guide. From the front page click "Administer."

In the "Site Building" section click "Modules."

Site building Control how your site looks and feels.
Blocks Configure what block content appears in your site's sidebars and other regions.
Menus Control your site's navigation menu, primary links and secondary links. as well as rename and reorganize menu items.
Modules Enable or disable add-on modules for your site.
Themes Change which theme your site uses or allows users to set.

Configure the Block

To configure the block so id displays on your site, go to the "Administration" page and click the "Blocks" link in the "Site Building" section.



Find the "Ubuntu Drupal Header" block. Select the drop down box to the right of it that currently says "None" and select a region for it. For the example, we will use the "Header" region.

This module has permission settings just like any other module. To get to these permissions, go to the "Administration" page and click the "Permissions" link.

User management
Manage your site's users, groups and access to site features.
Access rules List and create rules to disallow usernames, e-mail addresses, and IP addresses.
Permissions Determine access to features by selecting permissions for roles.
Roles List, edit, or add user roles.
User settings Configure default behavior of users, including registration requirements, e-mails, and user pictures.
Users List, add, and edit users.
