
To install the module, I will assume you already followed the UD Theme installation guide. From the front page click "Administer."

Configure the Block

To configure the block so id displays on your site, go to the "Administration" page and click the "Blocks" link in the "Site Building" section.



Find the "Ubuntu Drupal Sidebar" block. Select the drop down box to the right of it that currently says "None" and select a region for it. For the example, we will use the "Left Sidebar" region.
